


Speed Hump vs ~~Speed Bump~~

Average car is 14.7 feet long


3 inches high

12 feet wide

SPEED HUMP

- Much more gradual and gentler slope than speed bumps.
- 12 feet wide and 3 inches high in the middle (FCDOT Specifications).
- Parking on them is allowed.
- Used on residential and local streets.
- Ours will have cut-outs for emergency vehicles to pass through and not slow down

NOT THIS



4 to 6 inches high

12 to 24 inches wide

SPEED BUMP

- Much more abrupt and jarring than the much wider and lower speed humps.
- Used in parking lots and driveways. Not typically used on public roads.
- **FCDOT doesn't offer them or install them on public roads.**
